

Community Development Model



Phase 1: School Build

Building Education looks for project areas that are in dire need of help for a school rebuild due to damage from the 2015 earthquake. BE also looks to build new schools in remote villages. Most children in villages walk 1-2 hours one way to school. Building and rebuilding local schools supports to decrease the education drop-out rate.



Phase 2: Scholarships

25% of Nepal lives below the poverty line on 50 cents per day. Education in Nepal often comes with fees for admission, uniforms and materials. A family living in poverty cannot afford education for their children let alone food on the table. BE provides scholarships so children can change this and rise out of poverty.



Phase 3: Infrastructure

BE focuses on developing the infrastructure of villages to create sources of water and electricity that supplies the school and local homes. BE strives to work alongside the community and government so that it is equal effort on all responsible parties. BE believes that working together as partnerships instills ownership.



Phase 4: Sustainability

In the last stage, we focus on sustainability by creating local leaders in the community. We support the school and local people in starting income-generating businesses through micro-loans. This creates financial independence and allows BE to hand over leadership and financial responsibility to the local leaders.
